Who is this course for?

The course is designed for Scouts **13 or older** who are in PL or APL role or may be moving towards these roles.

When:

The Geelong Region Leadership Course is set to run over the weekend of 12-13-14 April 2024. The check in open on the Friday evening at 7:00pm, the course will commence at 8:30 pm SHARP. Concluding with a Final Parade and presentations at 3:00pm on Sunday.
