

Clean UP and Rubbish Disposal

- 1. Wash dishes after use.
- 2. Set table before breakfast, lunch & tea. (Remember a table cloth and to wipe the table before and after meals)
- 3. Clear tables after meals.
- 4. Empty rubbish bins.
- 5. Empty wet waste.
- 6. Hang tea towels out to dry.
- 7. Wipe downs sink, stove and bench tops.

Cooking and Food Storage

- 1. Cook and prepare all meals for the day.
- 2. Dispose of all left over food scraps correctly.
- 3. Refill fresh water containers.
- 4. Check ice & fresh food supplies. Order if needed.
- 5. Warn the P.L. before something runs out. (As orders have to be in the day before)
- 6. Make sure there is enough gas in the bottles.
- 7. Make sure Q-store is clean & tidy.
- 8. Make sure fire buckets are full and all safety equipment is correct.

Personal Duties


- 1. Make sure that your tent is brailed daily and sleeping bag is aired daily.
